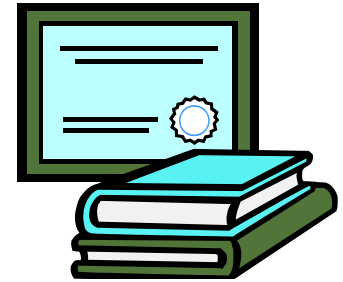
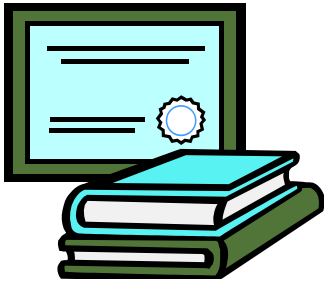


# College of DuPage Addictions Counselor Certification Program



## Master's Track\*

Students who have obtained a clinical master's degree in Counseling, Psychology, Human Services, Social Work, or a substantially similar field of study, must complete the following coursework:

### Program Requirements

**Introduction to Addictions** 4 credits

**Psychopharmacology** 3 credits

*(The above courses may be waived for equivalent completed coursework)*

**Addictions Counseling I** 4 credits

**Addictions Counseling II** 3 credits

**Fieldwork (300 - 500 hours)\*\*** 4 - 8 credits

*\*To be accepted into the master's track, a student must provide a transcript from an accredited clinical graduate program and meet with a full-time faculty member in Human Services to verify course equivalencies.*

*\*\*Fieldwork can only be taken after all other coursework is completed and a full-time instructor gives written permission to enroll. Prior graduate practicum in addictions may reduce the 500 hour internship requirement to 300 hours.*

*Upon completion of the training program and successfully passing the certification exam for addictions counselors, the student can be recognized as a CADC in Illinois.*
