The Nursing Department at the College of DuPage is proud to host the Rho Chapter of Alpha Delta Nu (ADN). Alpha Delta Nu is the National Honor Society for Associate Degree Nursing Students. It functions under the auspices of N-OADN, which is the National Organization for Associate Degree Nursing.

The Rho Chapter of ADN is open to 2nd year nursing students, by invitation only. In order to be considered for the honor society, the student must:

- Have a GPA of 3.0 in all courses required for the Associate in Applied Science in Nursing Degree
- Have earned no grades lower than a B in nursing courses (even if the course is repeated)
- Be in good standing in the nursing program

Student transcripts are evaluated after the completion of the first year of the nursing program; they will be notified of eligibility in the fall semester.

Students who accept the invitation to join the organization will participate in a community activity in order and maintain the above criteria in order to be eligible for induction. An induction ceremony will be held in the late spring.
